**Update – As of 09/01/2004:** The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) provides for the collection of a Congressionally mandated fee to be paid by certain aliens who are seeking status as nonimmigrant students (visa categories F-1, F-3, M-1, or M-3) or as nonimmigrant exchange visitors (visa category J-1). The purpose of this fee is to cover the costs for the continued operation of the Student and exchange Visitor Program (SEVP), including the administration and maintenance of SEVIS, compliance activities, and the establishment of SEVIS Liaison Officers. These SEVIS Liaison Officers will be a local resource for the schools and students, providing timely and accurate information or assistance in meeting the requirements of the program. ## FEE EXPLANATION

<b>New Student Testing:</b>	This is a per student fee and is non-refundable.
<b>Registration fee:</b>	This is a per student fee and is non-refundable.
<b>I-20 Application Processing Fee:</b>	This is a per student fee and is for the processing of the I-20 application and is non-refundable.
<b>IMF (Instructional Materials Fee):</b>	Textbooks, classroom materials, student planners, p.e. uniforms, yearbook and standardized testing.
<b>Academic Support:</b>	Educational field trips, mission trip deposits, graduation expenses (admin costs & regalia), and elementary end of the year activities.
<b>TEC</b>	Technology, Equipment, and Campus upgrades.
<b>ASB (Associated Student Body):</b>	Homecoming, prom, winter, spring and secondary end of the year activities.
<b>ESL (English as a Second Language):</b>	This fee is per student and must be paid with a separate cashier's check or money order. This fee is required for all international students. If, after testing, it is determined that ESL is not a necessary for the successful education of the student, this fee will be refunded.
<b>Campus Fund (per family):</b>	All new families will be charged a one-time fee to help defray capital improvement costs.
<b>Additional Services:</b>	Fees vary by program; please call the school office for specific information. Balametrics ESL (English as a Second Language) ILP (Independent Learning Program) SOS (Switched on Schoolhouse) Study Skills
<b>Sport Fees (per sport):</b>	Secondary - \$75.00  Other optional athletic expenses may be incurred dependent upon the sport (i.e. shoes, pictures, clothing, camps, physicals, traveling expenses, etc.,)
<b>Incidental Costs:</b>	<b>Before &amp; After School Care:</b> Monthly Costs: Before or After - \$125/student Before and After - \$250/student  There may be other incidental costs such as school pictures, lunches, seasonal items, sports uniforms, etc. that are not covered by the above listed fees.

<b>Pastoral Tuition Credit:</b>	Full-time pastors receive a credit of \$500 per family per year. Each year a letter verifying your pastoral position will be required with your enrollment form to receive credit.
